Special Transportation Requests

Staying Connected sometimes receives requests which are emergency, short notice or difficult to fill. Our Transportation Manager may directly contact those volunteers who express a willingness to accept special types of transports. Please circle the number below for those requests you would be willing to provide when available:

1. Last minute requests - emergency requests for service that could not be anticipated OR when unanticipated cancellation by volunteer (illness, family emergency);
2. Wheelchairs - volunteers who can lift, fold, and place wheelchair in their vehicle;
3. Savannah transports;
4. Charleston transports;
5. Procedures - volunteers willing to remain at a facility during an outpatient procedure, if required by the facility and if member has no one else to bring. This may involve a longer duration than other transports;
6. Specially-equipped vehicles - for a volunteer to drive when a member is temporarily unable to drive their vehicle and is unable to ride in a regular transport;
7. Pharmacy 'runs' (to be developed) - volunteers to pick up and deliver medications from a local pharmacy without member present. Note: member will have a pharmacy account and therefore no exchange of money required.
